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The action will enhance the crossborder eInvoicing B2G transactions in Europe and in Iceland, by contributing to the deployment of both the eDelivery and the eInvoicing Building Blocks.





DIRECTIVE 2014/55/EU

The Directive 2014/55/EU aims at promoting the eProcurement system among public administrations. In fact, since April 2019 public administrations have the obligation of accepting digital invoices.

Through this project, eight public entities from Iceland will update their systems and will be able to process electronic invoices from any country.

eInvoicing

Benefits of elnvoicing*

- Digital invoices provide significant savings such as reduction of costs of printing, postage, intraoffice routing and archiving are reduced.
- Data machine-readable elnvoices. Reduces the need of entering the invoice information into an AP system, saving human resources and reducing errors in data entry.

Why standardization?

The variety of e-Inovicing formats across EU causes complexity and high costs for business and public entities. In order to boost the single market, Europe agreed to introduce a European Standard for elnvoice. Therefore, the Commission has created a norm for a infrastructure that is being supplied by providers on the market.
